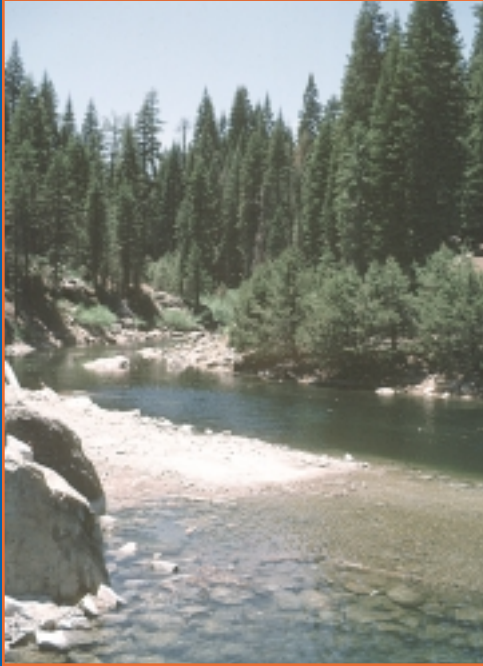


# PARTICIPATION OPPORTUNITIES

# PARTICIPATION OPPORTUNITIES



The Sacramento Municipal Utility District's cooperative relicensing process for the Upper American River Project is open to all stakeholders and the public, and participation is encouraged. The following summarizes the various types of meetings.

## Public Information Meetings

**Frequency:** Twice a year

**Timing:** Two hours during evening

**Location:** Various locations in Sacramento and El Dorado Counties

**Level of input:** Comments on relicensing process, issues, and resource measures for the new license term. These meetings are structured towards interested parties who want to stay abreast of progress and provide public comments.

## Plenary Group

**Frequency:** Variable, depending on work load, ranging from monthly to quarterly.

**Timing:** Six hours during daytime

**Location:** SMUD Customer Service Center

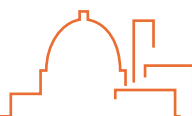
**Level of input:** Active participation in decision-making on: schedule and structure of the process, formation of issue questions and technical work groups, review and approval of study plans as well as resource measures generated by technical working groups. **Frequency:** Variable, depending on work load, ranging from monthly to quarterly.

**Timing:** Six hours during daytime
